THE SUITS WERE CHANGED TO STARS, STRIPES, SHIELDS AND EAGLES. APPARENTLY THESE PATRIOTIC PACKS DID NOT CATCH ON WITH CARD PLAYERS, AND PRINTERS SOON RETURNED TO THE TRADITIONAL PACKS.
