THE HUDSON-MOHAWK INDUSTRIAL GATEWAY

DURING THE 19TH CENTURY A GREAT CONCENTRATION AND VARIETY OF BUSINESSES AND INDUSTRIES SPRANG UP IN THE HUDSON-MOHAWK AREA. AS THE HUB OF TRANSPORTATION ROUTESFORMED BY THE MOHAWK AND HUDSON RIVERS, ERIE AND CHAMPLAIN CANALS, EARLY HIGHWAYS AND RAILROADS, THIS AREA WAS THE COMMERCIAL CENTER FOR NORTHEASTERN NEW YORK AND VERMONT. WATER POWER FROM SEVERAL STREAMS, POWER CANALS, AND THE MOHAWK RIVER PROVIDED ENERGY FOR MILLS STARTING IN THE 17TH CENTURY, TURNING WATERWHEELS AT FIRST, AND LATER TURBINES, INCLUDING THE MAMMOTH 60' X 22' BURDEN WHEEL. THIS ENERGY WAS THE ESSENTIAL RESOURCE FOR 19TH CENTURY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT.

THE GATEWAY IS A NON-PROFIT EDUCATIONAL CORPORATION WHOSE TRUSTEES AND MEMBERS ARE CONCERNED ABOUT 19TH CENTURY INDUSTRY AND INDUSTRIALLY RELATED BUILDINGS AND SITES AS WELL AS ONGOING INDUSTRIES ON BOTH SIDES OF THE HUDSON RIVER IN THE CITIES AND VILLAGES OF TROY, WATERFORD, COHOES, GREEN ISLAND, AND WATER-VLIET. GATEWAY FEELS THE FULLEST FUTURE OF THE AREA RESTS IN LARGE MEASURE ON SUCCESSFUL UTILIZATION OF THESE HISTORIC INDUSTRIAL RESOURCES IN A REVITALIZED URBAN ENVIRONMENT.

THE GOALS ARE: 1) CONTINUED OPERATION OF 19TH CENTURY INDUSTRIES AND PRESERVATION OF INDUSTRIAL AND INDUSTRIALLY RELATED BUILDINGS AND SITES THROUGH ADAPTIVE REUSE; 2) THE DEVELOPMENT OF TOURISM CENTERED ON THESE INDUSTRIES, BUILDINGS, AND SITES; AN EDUCATIONAL PROCESS COMMUNICATING THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE INDUSTRIAL HERITAGE AND MONUMENTS; AND THEIR RELATION TO PEOPLE AND COMMUNITIES TODAY; 3) STUDY OF INDUSTRIAL AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT IN AMERICA DURING THE 19TH CENTURY, FOCUSING ON THE HUDSON-MOHAWK AREA; PROVIDING THE EDUCATIONAL CATALYST TO CREATE AN APPRECIATION AND AWARENESS OF THE REGION'S HERITAGE.

ELLIE PATTISON AND JOHN KACHARIAN, PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE GATEWAY, ARE ACTIVE MEMBERS OF OUR SAND LAKE HISTORICAL SOCIETY.
