A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

AS A DIVERSION IN THE MIDST OF COPING WITH EVERYDAY WINTER PROBLEMS OR JUST A REFLECTION WHILE ENJOYING A COZY FIRESIDE ON A WINTER EVENING I OFFER THIS EPISODE OF HISTORIC MEMORABILIA.

I AM SURE EVERYONE RECALLS THE BIG THUNDER CELEBRATION OF LAST JULY 4TH AT HOAGS CORNERS. SINCE SAND LAKE PLAYED A VITAL PART IN THAT SEGMENT OF HISTORY, APPROPRIATELY THE DAY'S EVENTS OPENED WITH AN EXERCISE AT THE GRAVESITE OF DR. BOUGHTON IN THE SAND LAKE CEMETERY. BECAUSE ONLY A FEW WERE PRESENT, AND IN THE SPIRIT OF PRESERVING CURRENT EVENTS FOR POSTERITY, I WANT TO SHARE WITH ALL AND PERMANENTLY RECORD THE PERTINENT REMARKS DELIVERED THAT DAY BY KENNETH L. BROCK. THE FOLLOWING IS HIS TEXT IN ITS ENTIRETY.

*TODAY IN THE RURAL HILL
TOWNS OF RENSSELAER COUNTY,
INDEPENDENCE DAY IS CELEBRATED
NOT ONLY TO COMMEMORATE OUR 210
YEARS OF AMERICAN INDEPENDENCE
BUT ALSO THE INITIATION OF
INDEPENDENCE FROM THE
STRANGLEHOLD OF PATROON SYSTEM
SERVITUDE. THERE IS NO MORE
FITTING LOCATION FOR BEGINNING
OUR CELEBRATION THAN AT THE
GRAVESITE OF DR. SMITH
BOUGHTON.

AFTER YEARS OF LAND IMPROVEMENT, LOCAL FARMERS, FOLLOWING THE DEATH OF PATROON STEPHEN VAN RENSSELAER, WERE BEING EVICTED FROM THEIR HOMES.

IT WAS A MATTER OF RENT COLLECTION OR FORECLOSURE OF LEASES BY VAN RENSSELAER FAMILY HEIRS. THUS WAS BORN THE ANTI-RENT MOVEMENT. ALTHOUGH DISGUISED FROM HIS FRIENDS AND NEIGHBORS, THE LEADER, KNOWN AS 'BIG THUNDER,' WAS DR. SMITH BOUGHTON. HIS HOME WAS JUST UP THE ROAD IN THE HAMLET OF THE ALPS, AND HIS CHIEF ASSISTANTS, FRANK ABBOTT, KNOWN AS 'LITTLE THUNDER, AND THOMAS THOMPSON, CALLED 'TUSCARORA,' LIVED AT HOAGS CORNERS. TOGETHER THEY ORGANIZED LOCAL FARMERS AND MERCHANTS TO RESIST EFFORTS OF THE VAN RENSSELAERS WHO BY COURT ORDER WERE USING THE COUNTY SHERIFF AND HIS POSSE TO FORCE PAYMENT OR EVICTION. 'BIG THUNDER' PROVIDED LEADERSHIP FOR THIS POPULIST CAUSE HERE AND AS FAR AWAY AS ALBANY, SCHOHARIE, AND DELAWARE COUNTIES.

AMERICAN INDEPENDENCE WAS
PROCLAIMED THAT THOSE LIVING ON
SURROUNDING FARMS SOUGHT THEIR
INDEPENDENCE FROM PERPETUAL
LEASEHOLDS, DEMANDING REDRESS
OF THEIR PLIGHT BY THE NEW YORK
STATE LEGISLATURE.
REPRESENTING THE SAND LAKE
HISTORICAL SOCIETY, IT IS MY
PRIVILEGE TO JOIN WITH HISTORIC
HOAGS CORNERS ASSOCIATION IN
PLACING THIS WREATH ON THE
GRAVE OF DR. SMITH BOUGHTON,
'BIG THUNDER' OF THE ANTI-RENT
MOVEMENT. NEIGHBOR, FRIEND,
AND CHAMPION OF THE OPPRESSED
OF HIS TIME."

OUR OWN COUNTRY STORE

OUR TOWN OF SAND LAKE BOASTS A TURN-OF-THE-CENTURY COUNTRY STORE, GIFT SHOP AND GOURMET FOOD SHOP AT THE JUNCTION OF ROUTES 43, 66 AND TABORTON ROAD IN SAND LAKE. HAVE YOU VISITED THE COUNTRY TOKEN YET?

AUTHENTIC ANTIQUE CUPBOARDS AND CASES, A WOODBURNING 1906 PARLOR STOVE, AN 1880 FLOOR MODEL COFFEE GRINDER, AND A 1920 BRASS CASH REGISTER, COMPLEMENTED BY THE PERIOD COSTUMES OF OWNERS JOHN AND TERRY TOKRYMAN TAKE US BACK IN TIME.

GOURMET FOODS INCLUDE BLACK AND HERBAL LOOSE TEAS, COFFEE BEANS TO BE GROUND IN THAT COFFEE GRINDER, JAMS, JELLIES, HONEY, MAPLE PRODUCTS, HERBS AND SPICES. THE ANTIQUE OAK CANDY CASE HOLDS LUSCIOUS HAND-DIPPED CHOCOLATES AND TRUFFLES, 4-FOOT LICORICE WHIPS, AND 25-CENT BAGS OF CANDY.

HAND-CRAFTED JEWELRY, CANDLES, SCENTED SOAP, BENNINGTON POTTERY, BRASS, AND PEWTER WARE, DOLLS, TEDDY BEARS, AND HAND-THROWN POTTERY ARE AMONG THE MANY GIFT ITEMS WAITING TO BE IN THE COMPANY OF A BEAUTIFUL GREETING CARD AND WRAPPED IN GIFT WRAP FROM THE LOVELY SELECTION FOUND AT THE COUNTRY TOKEN.

BUILT IN 1830, THE BUILDING WAS IN THE MASH FAMILY FROM THE TURN.OF THE CENTURY UNTIL 1980, WHEN IT WAS PURCHASED BY THE TOKRYMANS. IT WAS THE SITE OF A GENERAL STORE AND POST OFFICE FOR MANY YEARS UNTIL 1978. A SECTION OF BRASS POST OFFICE BOXES STILL REMAINS.

THIS RETURN TO YESTERYEAR WILL BE A MEMORABLE JOURNEY FOR YOU.

MARCH 2, 1820 - THE MISSOURI COMPROMISE ACT WAS PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AT WASHINGTON. ITS REPEAL IN 1854 WAS ONE OF THE PRIME CAUSES OF THE CIVIL WAR. DO YOU REMEMBER YOUR HISTORY? MISSOURI, AS A NEW STATE, WOULD BE PERMITTED TO HAVE SLAVERY; MAINE'S ADMISSION TO THE UNION Would not be related to slavery in Missouri: Henry Clay was THE DOMINATING PERSONALITY IN ACHIEVING THE COMPROMISE: SLAVERY WAS A NATION-WIDE ISSUE IN THE PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN.

MARCH 9, 1862 - THE BATTLE OF THE MONITOR AND THE MERRIMAC -THE IRON-CLAD WARSHIP MERRIMAC WAS A CONFEDERATE NAVAL MONSTER AND THE MERRIMAC WAS CALLED A 'CHEESEBOX ON A RAFT'. THE CIRCULAR TURRET OF THE MERRIMAC WAS TURNED BY ENGINES AND HAD TWO OF THE MOST POWERFUL GUNS OF THE TIME. TWENTY SHOTS LEFT INDENTATIONS IN THE MERRIMAC'S ARMOR, BUT NO SHOT PIERCED HER SIDE. HOWEVER, THE ARMOR BEGAN TO LEAK AND IT RETIRED FOR REPAIRS. ONLY A FEW INJURIES AND NO DEATHS RESULTED, BUT THIS WAS A GREAT MORAL VICTORY FOR THE NORTH.

MARCH 16, 1802 - WESTPOINT MILITARY ACADEMY ESTABLISHED BY CONGRESS.

MARCH 31, 1918 - EASTER SUNDAY AT 2 AM ALL CLOCKS IN THE NATION WERE TURNED AHEAD ONE HOUR TO "SAVE DAYLIGHT" AND THUS CONSERVE FUEL FOR LIGHTING.
