#### CURRENT YEAR:

EDUCATIONAL - 1. Regular monthly membership meetings with quest speakers (and the videotaping of most presenations); 2. Field trips to historic sites; 3. Activities of special interest groups focusing on historically significant arts and crafts, the making of oral and/or video histories, genealogy, preservation and restoration; 4. The creation and maintenance of a library collection for the use of members and non-members; 5. Participation in enrichment programs relating to history in our public schools; 6. Maintenance of society archival materials; 7. Publication of newsletter (approx. four times annually); 8. Consulting and offering quidelines in preservation matters to local residents and to town government; 9. Offering awards to two graduating seniors of high school age for excellence in history; 10. House tour, open to the public, planned, publicized, and staffed by historical society members; 11. The promotion of house-dating and house plagues for older homes; 12. Participation in Victorian Picnic (Sand Lake community celebration).\* Fundraising: 1. Membership; 2. Spaghetti supper in conjunction with high school concert; 3. Tailgate (flea market) sale, participation in which was open to society members and others for the rental of spaces, and raffle. Sales and educational booth at Victorian Picnic.

#### PROPOSED ACTIVITIES:

Establishment of community awards honoring preservation efforts.

Surveying historic buildings and sites in township.

Provision of display case for an historically significant collection to be situated in town hall.

Gifts of video tapes for loan in the general circulation of our town library.

A second "tailgate" sale to be held this summer.
