
Afternoon Tea and Fireside Chat with William Kennedy! The Old Daley on Crooked Lake, Sunday, March 12, 2017

On Sunday, March 12, from 3:00 – 4:30 p.m., the Sand Lake Historical Society invites you to an *Afternoon Tea and Fireside Chat with William Kennedy* in the Great Room of The Old Daley on Crooked Lake.

Kennedy will (in his own words) "...focus on some of the history that I've uncovered either by living here for 53 years and being a summer habitué for a lot longer than that; the Prohibition era traffic out here, the Crooked Lake Hotel of my high school and college days, the existence of some vital commercial life in the area that I never knew about (and still don't know enough about), and whatever else comes up when I start rummaging through the attic of my memory. And I'll try to answer any questions people might have about my work."


This event will be the first opportunity to view 15 beautiful mailboxes, enhanced and decorated by local artists, to be available through silent auction. *More* >>>
